Dear Sean:

I am writing this letter to express the school's concerns about the continued relationship between BOYFL and Freedom High School. A number of district personnel and community members have expressed concern regarding the treatment of Freedom's facilities while your group has been using the field. We ask your cooperation in addressing these matters.

- 1) No alcoholic beverages, unopened or opened, are to be on campus at any time. BOYFL is responsible for notifying and supervising all spectators, participants, and personnel regarding this regulation.
- 2) All BOYFL automobiles, both administration and spectators, must be parked within the parking lots. No automobile may be inside gated areas. Immediate loading and unloading may occur, but vehicles are not to be left unattended and must immediately leave upon finishing loading or unloading.
- 3) BOYFL may not use the stadium on Wednesday nights as the Freedom band practices on these nights. BOYFL may use outlying fields that are not already rented out on those nights.
- 4) BOYFL must supervise students and spectators at all times. The track area surrounding the long jump, high jump, and pole vault pits are off limits. No student or spectator is allowed on any pit material, including cheerleaders.
- 5) BOYFL will announce at games: "Sunflower seeds and peanut shells are not allowed in the stadium. Violations can cause BOYFL to lose their stadium privileges."
- 6) No animals are allowed anywhere on Freedom's campus unless they are verified vision assistance dogs. Please be sure to let all visiting teams know of this policy before your events so this does not present a problem. Visiting squads can cause BOYFL to lose stadium rental rights.
- 7) No usage of the snack bar is permitted at any time unless Freedom Athletic Booster Personnel are present. The usage of the stadium ice machine is also off limits unless Athletic Personnel are present.
- 8) At 8:00pm, the lights will be turned off by LUHSD personnel. BOYFL personnel must supervise all of their constituents while on campus. No BOYFL player can be left on school grounds without supervision. Please let parents know they are to pick up their sons and daughters after their practices and games.

- 9) BOYFL participants and spectators are not to be on the tennis courts for any reason. If any suspicious activity is noted, call the Athletic Director immediately.
- 10) BOYFL is not to use the locker rooms, weight rooms, or any other area on campus unless prior authorization is given in writing by LUHSD or a designee.
- 11) BOYFL must clean the seating areas, both home and away once a week. School personnel may be hired for this duty at a price to be determined. All areas used should be left in the same state found or better.

In closing, we would like to see BOYFL become more proactive in addressing concerns rather than reactive. I am quite confident that you will address these issues so we can keep our working relationship in good standing.
